ADVOCATES ACT 1995 (APPOINTED DAY) (No. 1) ORDER 1996

Approved by Tynwald *15th July* 1996

Coming into operation in accordance with article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 34 of the Advocates Act 1995(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Advocates Act 1995 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 1996.

(2) This order shall come into operation on the date on which it is approved by Tynwald.

Appointed day

2. (1) Subject to the transitional provisions set out in the Schedule, the provisions of the Advocates Act 1995 which are specified in paragraph (2) shall come into operation on 1 September 1996.

(2) The provisions referred to in paragraph (1) are -

- (a) Part I;
- (b) section 33(1) and (2) but only to such extent as is necessary for the purposes of the amendments and repeals referred to in sub-paragraph (d) and (e);
- (c) section 34;
- (d) in Schedule 1 (amendment of enactments) , entries 2(a),

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5(a) and 6;

(e) in Schedule 2 (repeal of enactments), the entries relating to -

(i) the Isle of Man Law Society Act 1859;

(ii) the Isle of Man Law Society (Amendment) Act 1934;

(iii) sections 1(1) and 2, and the definition of "the Act of 1859" in section 29(1) of the Advocates Act 1976;

(iv) the Statute Law Revision Act 1983;

(v) paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Statute Law Revision Act 1989.

Article 2

SCHEDULE

TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. Except where the subject or context otherwise requires, this Schedule is without prejudice to the Interpretation Act 1976(b).

2. Paragraphs 4, 6 and 7 of this Schedule shall have effect until such time as alternative provision is made by bye-laws under Part I and the remaining provisions shall have effect until such time as the President, Vice-President and other officers of the Society are elected or appointed in accordance with such bye-laws.

3. In this Schedule -

"Part I" means Part I of the Advocates Act 1995;

"Society" means the Isle of Man Law Society.

4. The Bye-laws of the Society which were in operation immediately before the commencement of Part I shall, so far as they are consistent with that Part, have effect as if made under that Part.
5. The President, Vice-President, members of the Council and other officers of the Society who were in office immediately before the commencement of Part I shall continue to hold office as if elected or appointed under that Part.
6. General meetings of the Society shall be called and conducted in the same manner as they were called and conducted before the commencement of Part I.
7. Members of the Society shall be elected in the same manner as they were elected immediately before the commencement of Part I.

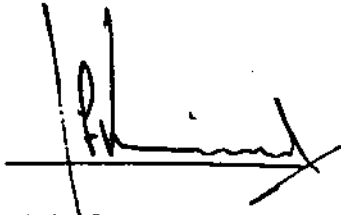
Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Advocates Act 1995 (Appointed Day) (No. 2) Order 1996.

Appointed day

2. (1) The provisions of the Advocates Act 1995 which are specified in paragraph (2) shall come into operation on 1 October 1996.
 - (2) The provisions referred to in paragraph (1) are -
 - (a) section 21 (establishment of advocates' fees committee);
 - (b) section 23(5) (regulations as to the assessment of advocates' bills of costs); and
 - (c) the other provisions of Part III of the Advocates Act 1995 but only to such extent as is necessary for the purpose of enabling the Advocates Fees Committee to make regulations under that Part.

(2) The provisions referred to in paragraph (1) are -

- (a) section 33(1) but only to such extent as is necessary for the purposes of the amendments referred to in sub-paragraph (b);
- (b) in Schedule 1 (amendment of enactments), entries 2(b), 3, 4, 5(b) and (c) and 12.

2. (1) Sections 15, 16, 17 and 18 of the Advocates Act 1995 shall come into operation on 18 May 1998 but only for the purpose of enabling the **Deemsters** to make regulations under and for the purposes of those sections

- (2) Sections 26 and 27 of the Advocates Act 1995 shall come into operation on 18 May 1998

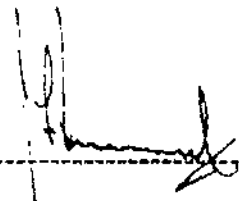
- (3) The following provisions of the Advocates Act 1995 shall come into operation for all purposes on 1 August 1999 -
